

ROCK AND POP INSTITUTE AUDITIONS

Thanks for your interest in the Warwickshire Rock and Pop Institute.
Auditions are being held on:

at Coten End Music Workshop, Coten End, Warwick CV34 4NP**

We are looking for outstanding guitarists, bassists, drummers, keyboard players and vocalists who enjoy performing in a variety of Rock and Indie styles.

THE AUDITION:

- 1 We will ask you to perform one of two set songs, either:
Purple Haze (Hendrix version in original key)
or
Fake Plastic Trees (Radiohead in original key)

For both set songs you are asked to get your sounds as close to those on the recordings as possible. You choose the song you want to perform.

(Keyboard players - If you wish to play Purple Haze, it's up to you as to what you feel is the most appropriate contribution you can make, as there are no keys on the original)

- 2 We will then ask you to jam around a 12 bar blues in various keys.
- 3 There will then be a chance for you to play us your favourite stuff on your own.

This will be followed by an opportunity for you to ask any questions you might have.

We expect the audition to last 10 – 12 minutes.

(Drummers - For the audition we will ask you to play a Yamaha electric kit. We appreciate that this will make a big difference to your playing but it saves a great deal of set up time and will allow us to see more people. Bear in mind that it will be the same for everyone. We believe that we will be able to ascertain your coordination, rhythmic and musical sensibilities regardless of the kit you play. If you need a double bass drum pedal please bring that with you).

(Guitarists/Bassists - We have a Fender Deluxe and a Mesa F50 Combo which you may use if you wish or you can bring your own amp. There is also a Workingman Bass combo).
