KINGSBURY OIL COMPLEX –EMERGENCY INSTRUCTIONS

This letter and the enclosed leaflet are being sent to you as a purely precautionary measure. They provide simple advice on what to do in the unlikely event of an emergency at the Kingsbury Oil Complex.

The Oil Complex stores and distributes a variety of petroleum and oil products and has been operating since 1969. The complex has an excellent safety record.

The companies operating at Kingsbury Oil Complex are Texaco Ltd, BP Oil UK Ltd, Warwickshire Oil Storage Limited and British Pipeline Agency. All companies have rigorous safety systems and procedures designed to prevent any accidents. Each company has also produced an 'on-site' emergency plan for their respective organisation which they test regularly.

Warwickshire County Council Emergency Planning Unit has produced an 'offsite' emergency plan, in conjunction with the emergency services, the site operators and other key partners. The plan is updated regularly and is designed to ensure that the effects on the local community are minimised in the event of any major incident.


Please read the enclosed leaflet carefully and keep it handy in case of an emergency.


