The competition prize is a half day trip in the Cotswolds in a chauffeured classic Watsonian Squire sidecar outfit, travelling from Blockley near Moreton-in-Marsh to Bourton-on-the-Water, for afternoon tea and cakes and back again. You will need to get yourself to and from Blockley and take a warm jacket and eye protection. We recommend you also take and wear a crash helmet, but this is not mandatory. There is no cash alternative.

One winner will be randomly drawn from all eligible entries received. The prize draw is open to UK residents only. Entrants must be aged 18 or over in order to take part and must have had their 18th birthday by 9 May 2010. A weight restriction of 150 kilo's (23.5 stones) applies. Entries are limited to one per person and employees of Warwickshire County Council and Warwickshire Police Road Safety Units are not permitted to enter the prize draw. The winner of the prize draw will be informed after the close of the competition at 5pm May 9th 2010.
