

Middleton Roadshow: 22nd February 2006

1. There was an opportunity to have some refreshments and browse the documents and flyers relating to primarily the Minerals consultation, but also the Waste consultation.
2. The meeting was very informal with much time for detailed discussion before we started the formal presentation at 7 pm.
3. Suzanne Osborn gave a brief presentation on the Minerals Development Framework consultation process
4. Jim Davies gave a presentation on the Minerals Development Framework itself.

Then there was an opportunity for questions and answers. Most of the questions were around one of the sites in the existing Minerals Local Plan – Lea Marston. Some of the answers were provided on the night whereas other questions were deferred and our considered answers are included in the table below:

Questions	Answers
1. Problem of noise and times of operation. Could WCC please ensure that it is reasonable – sent letter 2 or 3 weeks ago.	Conditions attached to planning permission are there to control against problems such as noise and times of operation. Where conditions are not adhered to officers take this seriously and investigate a possible breach of conditions and consider the necessary enforcement action to be taken.
2. Dust and noise is a real problem if you own land close to the quarry.	This comment has been noted and will be continue to be considered through the planning application process.
