Judging Criteria

The pieces of art entered into this competition will be reviewed by a panel of local artists, who will assess the work according to the following criteria.

First Impression

The judges will be looking for how well the art piece relates to the competition brief. Is it the correct size, if collage is it laminated

Scale points 1 to 5

5 points awarded to a piece which fully meets competition brief

How creative?

The judges will consider the difficulty of the piece, considering the amount of time taken to produce.

Scale point 1 to 5

Craftsmanship

The Judges will be looking at the materials used to create the piece, as well as considering its presentation.

Scale points 1 to 5

5 points awarded to a piece excellently presented

Is it eye catching – has it got wow factor?

The judges will look at the impact of the piece, Considering it's ability to communicate its message across to the viewer.

Scale points 1 to 5

5 points awarded to a eye catching piece which communicates a strong obvious message

Originality

The judges will consider the novelty of the piece

Points on a scale of 1 to 5 will be awarded for the originality of the piece
