The subject matter should fit into the brief provided.

The style of artwork is open and can be created in any medium, such as drawing, painting, photos, cartoon, if you wish to submit a collage or other 3 dimensional piece of work please take a photograph or laminate the work.

Entries must be no larger than A4 in size and 2 dimensional.

All artwork must be suitable for a family audience .

All artwork must be an original, entirely of your own work and not include any copyrighted material

work must be submitted by Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2008
