MARKET PROFILE

- ★ 1.7 Million people fall within the Royal Leamington Spa retail catchment. (CACI 2009)
- ★ 25% of the total catchment earn above £45,000 per annum, which is significantly above the national average. (CACI 2009)
- ★ The town benefits from an extremely loyal core shopper population, attracting 72% market share in its primary retail catchment.
- ★ Leamington Spa ranks 24th most affluent area in Great Britain. (PROMIS 2009)
- ★ Leamington Spa currently has retail space of 150,000 sq ft in Royal Priors Shopping Centre, 75,000 sq ft in Regent Court Shopping Mall as well as the multiple operators already in the town like House of Fraser, Paperchase, River Island, Republic and Boots.
- ★ The most affluent AB social grade, represents 32% of the total catchment of shoppers, this is significantly above the national average. (CACI 2009)



WARWICKSHIRE JUSTICE CENTRE

The new five storey 6,500sqm Warwickshire Justice Centre has been built on the site of the former magistrates' court on Newbold Terrace in Leamington Spa town centre.

This is the first centre in the country where all Justice Agencies, including Crown Courts, have been co-located, leading the way forward in shared services and improving efficiencies in the public sector. This unique development which opened in August 2010, has brought over 400 members of staff to Leamington town centre and will attract up to 300 visitors per day.

TRANSPORT LINKS

Chiltern Railways

If you think our way, travel our way.



Leamington Spa sits at the heart of the motorway network and has excellent links to the M6, M40, and M42.

Rail links from the town are excellent and Chiltern Railways are demonstrating this through their current enhancement programme. A £250 million investment along Chiltern Railways entire route will transform rail travel to London Marylebone from Leamington Spa. It's the biggest change to this service in a decade. Leamington Spa will be just over an hour from the capital, with peak time trains getting to London in 67 minutes. Improvements to the service include:

- Peak journeys: Up to 18 minutes faster to and from London.
- Off-peak journeys: Up to 19 minutes faster to and from London.



CREATIVE AND CULTURAL INDUSTRIES

Leamington Spa is home to a growing sector of cultural and creative industries within the county.

Spencer Yard Cultural Quarter is at the centre of revitalisation, bringing together a wealth of exciting activities. Althorpe Enterprise Hub is a brand-new centre providing fully-furnished office premises, specifically suited towards businesses operating in the high-technology and creative sectors. The recently refurbished railway arches known as Court Street Creative Arches provides spacious multi-use workspace for businesses in the creative, arts and media sectors and professional networks such as the Coventry and Warwickshire Social Media Café.

Leamington Spa is also the epicentre for the computer gaming industry. With over 1,300 employed in the sector in the West Midlands alone, collectively the East and West Midlands regions support a workforce that closely rivals London.

Major players based in Leamington Spa include: Freestyle Games, Blitz Games Studios and Codemasters (pictured right).
