

Warwickshire **Climate Change Partnership**

How do you feel about climate change?
Responses to the questionnaire.

- The most common first words that comes to mind about climate change are: carbon, global warming and weather followed by: challenge and trouble.
- 95% of respondents strongly agree or agree that the world's climate is changing.
- 98% of respondents think there will be negative impacts from climate change in the UK.
- The majority of respondents think that increasingly severe weather (droughts, floods) will be the most significant negative impact.
- 83% of respondents think that tackling climate change will present positive opportunities in the UK
- The majority of respondents think those opportunities will be: less waste of resources followed equally by better and more energy efficient homes, more locally grown food and more awareness of the impacts of our actions on other places.
- 95% of respondents strongly agree or agree that changes in personal behaviour can make a difference to the rate of climate change.
- 90% of respondents think that communities should be encouraged to develop their own local renewable energy generation.
- The majority of respondents think that around 20% - 30% of total renewable energy generation in Warwickshire should come from community scale projects, 40% - 50% should come from commercial scale projects and 10% - 20% should come from domestic or micro scale projects.
