Stratford Climate Action Network

Stratford Climate Action Network was established in 2006. It brings together village groups, church groups and others. It is also supported by the local Friends of the Earth group and is linked to the Stratford Local Agenda 21 committee.

Stratford Climate Action Network have had several public forums, starting with a debate between the political parties where 70 people attended. This was followed by an excellent talk from Gary Charnock from Ashton Hayes a village near Chester that is aiming to become the first "Carbon Neutral" Village in Britain.



Other subjects covered have ranged from Sustainable Energy, Transport, and Local Food. After a recent talk from Dr Tina Fawcett of the Environmental Change Institute, University of Oxford on "Personal Carbon Rationing" (CRAG). A CRAG group has been set up by 10 supporters to monitor their own carbon emissions over the next year.
