Background

- Sample size was 2,735.
- Response rate of 22.8% (predicted 20%)
- Sample over-representative of females, older people, Rugby and North Warwickshire residents and home owners
- Sample under represented by males, younger people, Nuneaton & Bedworth residents, non-whites, and people who are classified as having other and shared ownership of their home
- All data weighted to account for over/under representation

(c) Combining the results

There may be a need to combine responses to all twelve service types to produce an overall indication of ease of access to services. This could be done in several different ways. The methodology presented here is similar to the one adopted by the Home Office to measure overall perceptions of anti-social behaviour, and is used elsewhere in the Local Area Agreement. This approach has also been used, for this indicator, in the recent Narrowing the Gap analysis.

Responses to each service type are scored, from 5 (very easy) through to 1 (very difficult). Responses to all twelve questions are combined to give a potential maximum score of 60 for each respondent. Respondents with a score of 42 or more are considered, in this approach, to find it 'easy' in overall terms to access services. The score of 42 has been chosen as the threshold as this would require a respondent to provide (on average) six 'fairly easy' and six 'neither easy not difficult' responses.
