As part of the Market Hall Museum's 60th Anniversary Celebrations, Heritage Education have commissioned an artist and a poet to work with primary school children.

The two hour facilitated workshop with an artist or poet will include:

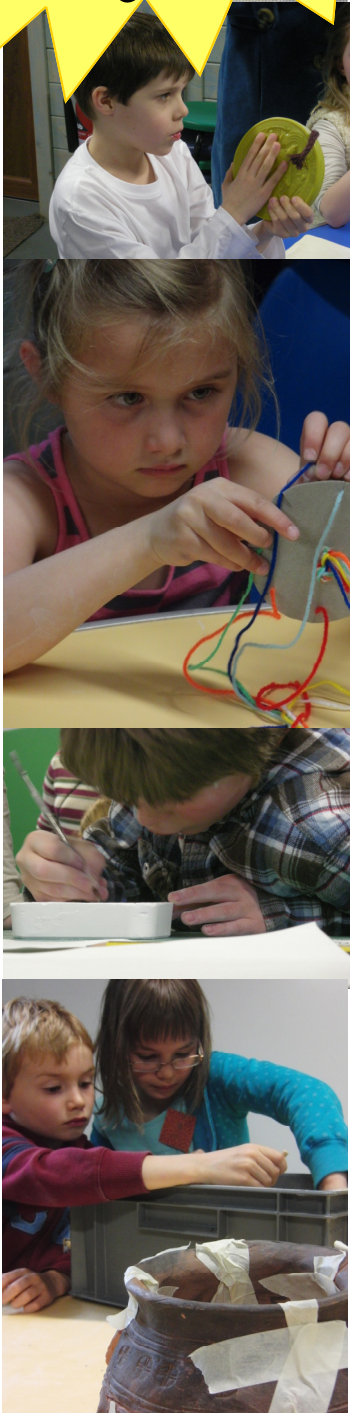
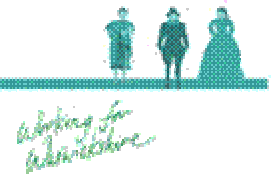
- A chance to explore some of the 60 objects on display: What are they? What's their story?
- Instruction on how to use a chosen object as inspiration for a piece of artwork or creative writing.
- Exploration of different techniques to create a piece of artwork or creative writing; some pieces will be chosen to be displayed in our 2012 exhibition
- Choose between two different media: creative writing with poet Jacqui Rowe or 3D artwork using recycled materials with artist Ros Ingram

Half Day Project Dates: Wednesday 4th January - Friday 30th March 2012

Cost: £120 per session for a group of up to 36 pupils (usual price £200).
