

# WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL LOCAL TRANSPORT PLAN 3

Warwickshire County Council is reviewing its Local Transport Plan (LTP), the third LTP will be in place from April 2011. This newsletter aims to keep you updated with how the preparation of the LTP is progressing and how you can help influence the contents of the final Plan.

## Issues & Priorities Consultation (Stage 1)

Over the summer 2009 we undertook the first stage of our LTP3 consultation programme. This involved asking partner organisations and Warwickshire residents to give us their views on the relative importance of the national transport goals in Warwickshire and to tell us what are the most important issues in Warwickshire to help achieve these goals.

### Headline Results

Respondents prioritised the 5 National Goals in the following order:

		<b>Average Rank</b>
1	<b>Goal 2</b> – Supporting economic growth with reliable transport networks	2.63
2	<b>Goal 1</b> – Tackling Carbon Emissions	2.83
3	<b>Goal 4</b> – Better safety and travel modes that are beneficial to health	3.14
4	<b>Goal 5</b> – Improve quality of life for transport users	3.18
5	<b>Goal 3</b> – Improving equality and fairness for our residents	3.24

*Responses have been prioritised based on the 'average rank'. Where average rank scores are relatively close together, this indicates there was no overall consensus in agreeing the priorities*

## Next Steps

We are seeking views of the public and partner organisations to help inform the contents of LTP3. We will be asking you for your views at these stages:

**Stage 2:** This is your opportunity to identify your preferred 'packages of transport options' and put forward your suggestions for schemes to help deliver the overall transport goals. This stage of the consultation will take place in **January and February 2010**.

*(Before the wider public consultation we will ask key partner organisations and groups for their thoughts and opinions, this will help inform the public consultation)*

**Stage 3:** We will publish the complete draft LTP3 – this will be your opportunity to comment on the draft Plan. The draft Plan will be available for comment in **Spring 2010** (exact dates to be confirmed).

## How You Can Participate

Your views are important - this is your opportunity to help shape future transport delivery in your local area. You can participate at each stage of the consultation in three different ways;

### Your local Community Forum

Your local Community Forum will provide further information at each stage of the consultation including the appropriate consultation material. Community Forum meetings are held throughout the year.
