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## “What was it like to live here in the past?” Old Maps

Within this section you will find copies of Ordnance Survey Maps showing the old factory sites in Nuneaton and Bedworth from 1900-1960. The Maps are named according to the map sheet number and then by date. Within this section you will find the following:

### County Series :

OS XI 13 1903 A, B, C = Area between Nuneaton and Bedworth, including brick works, brick and pipe works, elastic web works and foundry.

OS XI 13 1924 A,B,C = As above, also another elastic webs works and a sheet metal works

OS XI 09 1903 A,B,C,D = Nuneaton area, including Anker Mill, Nuneaton Wool Works, Attleborough Mill, Trent Valley Mills, a saw mill, a hat factory, Abbey Mill and a flour mill.

OS XI 09 1924 A, B, C = As above, also Newdegate Dye Works, a clothing factory and a hosiery factory. Trent Valley Mills no longer appears on the map (closed)..

OS XVII 05 1904 A,B = Bedworth area, including brick works, two hat factories and a tape mill

OS XVII 05 1938 A,B = As above, also hosiery works and another hat factory. Tape mill no longer appears on the map (closed)
