Who is on the Board?

The members of the Board include:

- People with a learning disability
- Family Carers
- Voluntary Organisations who provide services
- Health
- People from Adult Health and Community Services

The Partnership Board is Co-chaired by Warwickshire County Council's Commissioning Lead for Learning Disabilities in Warwickshire and a Learning Disability Representative.

What is important to the Board?



- To make sure the views and priorities of people with a learning disability are heard, respected and thought about.



- To make sure that the Joint Commissioning Strategy 'A Good Life for Everyone' 2011 - 2014 and Valuing People Now, White Paper is delivered and the lives of local people with a learning disability are improving.



- Sharing of local and national information, publicising the Partnership Board meetings and having minutes in easy read with pictures and audio.

Subgroups



The Partnership Board monitors the work and delivery plan of the Joint Commissioning Learning Disability Strategy.

The strategy has 7 key themes and subgroups to carry out its work:

- Choice and Control** - People want more Choice and Control
- A Fulfilled Life** - People want to have a more fulfilled life.
- A Place to Live** - People want a safe and secure place to live.
- Good Health** - People want to be healthy and well.
- Support for Family Carers** - Carers want a fulfilled life of their own.
- Keep Safe** - People want to feel safe.
- Seldom Heard Groups** - People and carers want to be more involved in the development of services and support.

The Partnership Board also links in with:

New Ideas Valuing People Now - (County Forum) - this group is made up of adults with a learning disability from across Warwickshire.
