

FREE WHEELIE BIN STICKERS

Guidelines

- Please do not leave the bin out for longer than necessary. Once the bin has been emptied it must be placed back onto your property.
- The bin must only be put out on collection day – this provides more impact.
- Place the bin so that it is visible to passing traffic i.e. side on to oncoming traffic.
- The bin must not cause an obstruction on footways or the road.
- The sticker is for Wheelie Bin use only – misuse of the sticker could be classed as vandalism.
- Only use 1 sticker per bin.



Instructions

- Ensure that the side of the bin is clean and dry.
- Peel off the backing and locate the sticker on one side of the bin – you will need to decide which side is best depending on the direction of traffic. Due to the way bins are emptied, do not place sticker on the back of the bin as this will ruin the sticker.
- The sticker is relatively large and it is likely that air bubbles will appear when it is applied to the bin. To avoid air bubbles you may wish to gently put pressure on the sticker with a sponge or cloth as you apply it.
- Air bubbles are cosmetic and will not affect the life of the sticker, however you may wish to remove them by piercing the bubbles with a pin or needle to remove any trapped air.

Remember the stickers have greater impact by only being on display on bin collection day. Please do not alter how you use the bin and locate it too close to the road where it may pose a danger.
