Inspire is a scheme which aims to give easy access to public, national, and higher education libraries.

The programme encourages and helps libraries from all sectors to work together. It also gives access to libraries in further education colleges, universities, schools and special libraries, including some in the NHS trusts.

Libraries in Coventry and Warwickshire, have been working collaboratively together to provide improved, easy access to the wealth of information resources held locally.

We offer a managed referral service between participating libraries so you can access resources in other institutions.

Our aim is to provide better support to learners and work together to share our resources for the benefit of people in Warwickshire and Coventry.
