**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH SM136,
FENNY COMPTON/BURTON DASSETT**

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order pursuant to sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, temporarily closing part of Public Footpath SM136 to all traffic at the footbridge at the Fenny Compton/Burton Dassett parish boundary (grid reference 4111 5365). The closure was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public owing to the disrepair of the bridge.

The Order commenced on 8 June 2009 and was due to expire on 21 November 2009. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order shall continue in force until the works to which it relates have been completed, or until 21 May 2010, whichever is the sooner (unless the Secretary of State extends the Order by a further direction).

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of path to be closed (if any) will be maintained at all times.

An alternative route will be available and shown on plans displayed on site.
